From Dr. Rob Quicke, Founder CRD, about his CRD Delegation to the White House:

During our time there we met with *Senior Advisor to the President*, Valerie Jarrett, and Kyle Lierman, *Associate Director of Public Engagement and Senior Policy Advisor*, to discuss, on-the-record, the government's "It's On Us" Campaign to End Campus Sexual Assault. Additionally, the group then met with Cecelia Munoz, *Assistant to the President and Director of the Domestic Policy Council*, and James Kvaal, *Deputy Director of the White House Domestic Policy Council*, to discuss the topic of college affordability.

After this we had a tour of the West Wing, which included a photo session in the Press Briefing Room with Josh Earnest, *Assistant to the President and Press Secretary*. This was followed by a lively discussion in the Roosevelt Room on the role of the media, and the importance of student media especially. College radio was specifically discussed also.
